

LFR Camper Rules & Hints

All campers must abide by these rules and guidelines. Breaking any rule will result in a warning. Second time offenders of the same rule will have recreational privileges removed. Severe breaking of the rules could result in being sent home. For the camper's safety and maximum enjoyment of the week, they should obey all of the rules and follow all the guidelines.

The Obvious...

- No fighting, stealing, cursing, drinking alcohol, illegal drugs or tobacco.

The Less Obvious...

- No rock, stick or pine cone throwing
- No PC (Physical Contact) with opposite sex—hand holding, kissing etc.
- No gum chewing
- No littering on the camp grounds
- No phone calls without director's approval
- No bare feet outside
- No improper clothing (short shorts, skirts, halter tops or revealing swim wear; Guys must wear a shirt at all times unless in your cabin, swimming or skiing/tubing).

Not to Mention...

- No graffiti anywhere
- No running in buildings (except the gym)
- No food or drink allowed in the cabins, Recreation Hall or Lakeview without special permission from the director.

Please Remember...

- No entering off-limit buildings or areas—including Lakeview & Dining Hall (unless invited in), Recreation Hall, Camp Store and Snack Shop, into any wooded area without staff, down or across levee road located behind the Dining Hall (without staff), around the lake (without staff)
- Don't go beyond the gazebo and camp office unless going to the Hitching Rail
- Boys stay as far away from the girls' cabins as the road in front of them and girls do the same
- Campers should not go on the pier unless they are getting into a paddle boat or if they are next in line to ski or tube.

For Safety Reasons...

- No running or fishing on the pier
- No swimming in the lake (we have a pool, though...)
- No unsafe use of the boats (standing, bumping, dangling feet, overloading or rocking)
- No paddling boats out of view of the "T" pier (Junior Campers must have an adult in the boat with them)
- CAMPERS MUST WEAR A LIFE PRESERVER WHEN THEY ARE IN A BOAT—STATE LAW

Cabin Time...

When someone says the words "Cabin Time," the campers must immediately go directly to their cabin. Once the campers get to the cabin, they must wait for the counselor to arrive for further instructions for concluding the evening; no camper should be outside of the cabin after cabin time without being accompanied by a counselor.

Other Helpful Hints...

Bank

The bank is open anytime the Recreation Hall Counter is open. Times will be available each morning, afternoon, and evening. If a camper has a lot of money, it is a good idea to put some of it in the bank to avoid possibility of losing it.

Snack Shop & Camp Store Hours

The Snack Shop and Camp Store are open each morning, afternoon, and evening. Hours will be announced.

Cabin Clean-up

Cabin clean-up will take place most mornings before breakfast. The girls' cabins will compete against each other and the boys cabins will do likewise. Each day the cabin will be judged as follows:

- Beds made and stuff put away neatly under the bed - 50 pts.
- Floors swept and mopped - 50 pts.
- Bathrooms and sinks clean - 50 pts.
- Overall appearance - 50 pts.

5 pts. off for every camper in the cabin when the cabin checker arrives. Winners and losers will be announced at lunch with the overall winners and losers getting their just rewards on the last night of camp.

Mail

Campers can buy stamps and stationery in the Camp Store and the mail box is in the Recreation Hall just outside the Camp Store; camper mail and e-mail will be given out each evening. Campers will not be able to send email while at camp.

Camp Picture

All campers will wear their camp shirt on the first morning for a picture; the last opportunity to order a picture will be immediately after the picture is taken. Campers who order the 8x10 photo will also receive a photo CD for no extra charge.

Recreation Equipment

Recreation equipment may be checked out at the Recreation Hall counter (or Lakefront Shop for boating equipment). Campers will be charged for equipment that is returned damaged.

Boating

EVERYONE IS REQUIRED TO GET A LIFE PRESERVER IN THE LAKEFRONT SHOP! Campers under age 12 must have an adult in the boat; when finished with boats, please secure paddle boats on pier, canoes and aluminum boats completely on shore. Campers must return the life preserver to the Lakefront Shop.

Tubing

Campers must pass a swimming test at the pool before tubing and may tube only after being sent down to the pier by the Lifeguard or Adult Volunteer.

Fishing

No fishing license is required. Campers can take cleaned fish to their counselor to be placed in the freezer and marked with their name.
