

Dear Fisherman,

It is almost time once again for the Father/Son Fishing Retreat at Lake Forest Ranch. So start thinking about pulling out your fishing gear, practice your casting and reserve those dates **April 9-10** on your calendar for a time of great fun and fishing and spiritual growth.

This retreat is open to any man and his son(s) or man without sons who will spend the weekend as a fishin' buddy with a young man from the Columbus based Palmer Home for Children (or with any young boy who does not have a father available to bring him that you may want to bring). Along with the fishing will be times for fun, games, Bible study, singing and just hanging around together. We will have two great Bible study times led by Michael King who is with PaperCrown Productions in Tuscaloosa, AL. Michael was one of our summer camp videographers for summer '09. He is a recent graduate of Dallas Theological Seminary in Dallas, TX.

The retreat will officially begin Friday evening April 9 at 7 p.m. with supper. For those able to arrive early, fishing will be available beginning at 3:00 that afternoon. Registration will take place from 5:00 - 6:45 p.m. The weekend will conclude after a fish fry supper Saturday evening April 10. Costs for the retreat will be \$60.00 per man and \$40.00 per boy (age 6-18). This includes four meals, one night's lodging, the fishing (no license required), and all the recreation and program fees.

Be sure to bring plenty of fishing gear. Several years ago the lake was restocked with Largemouth Bass, Red Ear & Blue Gill Bream, and Channel Catfish. There are quite a few Crappie in there too, though we aren't sure how they got there. Live bait will work extremely well for all of these fish. There are some pretty large bass in the lake so you might be able to catch a big one. You don't want to miss this great time together and on the lake. Feel free to bring a small boat and trolling motor if you like. A few boats will be available here at the camp too. Bring extra clothes just in case the big one pulls you in. Don't forget to bring a sleeping bag or twin sheets, blanket, a pillow, towels, soap, and your Bible. **SPECIAL NOTE:** All college age men who would like to attend and be a fishin' buddy with a Palmer boy for the weekend may attend at no charge! Any man who signs up to be a fishin' buddy with a Palmer boy will not have to pay the registration fees for the boy, but paying for your own fee will be appreciated. It would be helpful if those guys would bring extra fishing tackle in case any of the Palmer Home boys don't have it.
