

# What-2-Pack

We are excited that you will be spending part of your summer at LFR! These are some things to keep in mind before you arrive. First, here is a list of what to bring and not to bring as you pack.

**CLOTHING:** Please bring enough to last the entire camp.

- Shorts (not too short or revealing)
- T-shirts (avoid ones with crude or rude imprinting please)
- Swimwear (modest; two-piece swimsuits must be accompanied by a T-shirt), pool shoes
- Shoes – bring an extra pair of comfortable (tennis) shoes in case a pair gets wet (Tennis shoes required for the ropes course and Tennis Shoes or Boots required for horseback riding)
- Rain gear
- Theme Night clothing

**OTHER:**

- Bible & pen, alarm clock towels, bedding for twin-sized bunk bed (sleeping bag or sheets), pillow, flashlight, basic necessities like toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, soap, etc.

**OPTIONAL:**

- Camera, insect repellent, recreation equipment; LFR does provide much of the recreation equipment, but some campers prefer to bring their own. Please put name & phone # on it.

**PLEASE DO NOT BRING:**

- Electronic equipment such as CD or cassette players, MP3s, IPODs, laptops, cell phones, radios; alcoholic beverages, cigarettes or chewing tobacco, illegal drugs; knives, fireworks, rifles or bows, jewelry or other expensive items; chewing gum (it tends to stick to everything).

**Bring \$20 or \$30** for purchases in the Snack Shop and Camp Store. (Some of the games in the Rec Hall are coin operated, so bring some quarters too.) A bank is available for campers to safely store their money. An 8x10 group picture of your week will be taken and a photo CD and together they may be purchased for \$6 as you come through the registration line.

**Cabin sign-up** is done upon arrival at camp. You may have up to **TWO** friends room with you.

**Campers may not call home** except in the event of an emergency. Parents who need to contact their children for emergencies may call (662) 726-5052. Please do not send your child with a cell phone.

**E-mail** may be sent to campers during their camp week by Bunk1. You can go to [www.bunk1.com](http://www.bunk1.com) or [www.lakeforestranch.bunk1.com](http://www.lakeforestranch.bunk1.com) and continue on to the next step. An instruction flier has been mailed out to your church leader for reference. You may also print out the instruction sheet yourself by going to our website. Bunk1 will send the emails at 7:00 am each day of camp. We will hand out those emails at supper each night. We also encourage letters and packages for your children.

**LFR is located** halfway between Macon and Louisville off MS Hwy 14. For detailed directions check our website.

*From Columbus or Meridian* take U.S. Hwy 45 to get to Macon – then go 13 miles west on MS Hwy 14 – turn right at the green Lake Forest Ranch sign onto Lake Forest Road – follow signs to camp.

*From Jackson* take MS Hwy 25 to get to Louisville – then go 10 miles east on MS Hwy 14 - turn left at the green Lake Forest Ranch sign onto Yellow Creek Road – go 9 miles to camp.
